




YEAR 1 SPRING TERM

- **Reading - Sharing books frequently with your child and reading with your child at least three times a week when they begin the school reading scheme. Visiting the local Libraries, visiting the school website and www.oxfordowl.co.uk**
- **Doing /making - Practicing holding of pencil and having control of the fine motor movement. Using number in everyday contexts such as ages, house numbers, counting steps up and down stairs, socks, using language such as bigger/smaller, heavy/light.**
- **Visiting - Going to a park and looking at the weather, can you see the changes in the weather i.e. is there frost on the ground, maybe it has snowed. How does it feel? What has happened to the tree's and plants, have new buds formed?**
