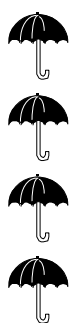

- And much more


You can support your learning at home by:
